- Do not publicly criticise or engage in demeaning descriptions of others, including online.
- Do not keep your concerns about abuse or poor practice secret. Inform the League's Safeguarding Officer, either directly yourself, or indirectly via your Team Captain, if you have any concerns about abuse, or any other breach of this Code of Conduct.
